# 1974 Brings New Gym Addition to MCS



This year saw the completion of the new gymnasium addition. Construction difficulties had delayed completion until January, forcing the meeting of gym classes in the balcony, the use of other practice facilities, and the rescheduling of home games. The new year brought the finishing touches with the painting of a larger basketball court and the installation of new bleachers. The new gym provides an additional area of 2035 square feet and a doubled seating capacity. Two separate teaching facilities may be created by drawing a net partition.
































# Seniors Brew "Arsenic and Old Lace"

# Inexperience Hobbles Mustang Football Team











Outstanding players were Kevin Collier and Joe and Randy Miller. Randy won the Rotary Club M.V.P. trophy for 1973.


