Divers Search Morris Lake For 30 Minutes to Find Body

Morris—A New Lisbon father who could not swim drowned in Hargrave Lake here this weekend before the frantic eyes of his wife, a novice swimmer, and three children, police said.

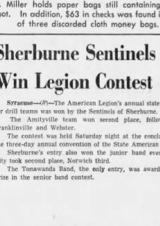

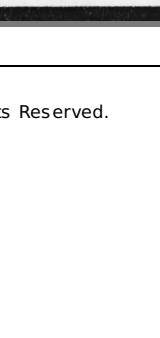
